



Make SARS' Tax Exemption on a donation made, count for you

Many people support a deserving cause, but if you do not have one yet, please consider **Employment Solutions for People with Disabilities**. We want to offer you the opportunity to pay less tax when donating to a Section 18A approved organisation like Employment Solutions. We 'give back' by issuing you with a Section 18A Tax Deduction Certificate. Section 18A donors' taxable income is reduced with the value of the donation, which can either be in cash or property/goods. Business entity donations can also earn their companies BBBEE (we are a level 4 contributor) and CSI benefits.

(The SARS Tax Exemption Guide, 2007:25: A taxpayer making a bona fide donation in cash or property made in kind to a section 18A approved organisation, is entitled to a deduction from his taxable income if the donation • is supported by the necessary receipt issued by the organisation; and • does not exceed 10% of the taxable income of the taxpayer, calculated before allowing any deduction under section 18A or any deduction for medical and dental expenses.)
